Policy Statement

CLG maintains a zero waste to landfill policy for its collection programs with a focus on providing the best quality output streams and working towards achieving a sustainable circular economy while maintaining best practice for responsible environmental management and the health and safety of employees and stakeholders. CLG uses proprietary and innovative materials separation processes with all items recycled with zero waste to landfill. CLG is committed to managing our operations in an environmentally responsible way and the prevention of pollution and harm to the environment.

Objectives

CLG commits to:

- Ensuring that the framework and commitment for setting and reviewing environmental objectives and targets are realised.
- Demonstrate, via external verification, compliance with external industry standards applicable to each operating region. Standards include ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 45001 and R2 (US and Australia only).
- Maintain a management system consistent with the requirements of the International Standard for Environment Management Systems (ISO 14001) with a key focus on continual improvement.
- Ensure that hazardous and other focus materials are identified and managed locally adhering to the Basel Convention to protect human health and ensuring environmentally sound management of product(s).
- Provide a recycling solution for an industry where previously nearly all waste went to landfill or developing countries and by doing so, our innovative approach is paying dividends for the environment, human health, and business.
- Reduce energy and water consumption and waste produced by our process where economically viable.
- Strive to comply with eStewards standards globally. This is managed and monitored internally.
